

Falcon 900



The Falcon 900 is a technologically advanced business jet and first began in 1986. It has a low/swept wing and 3 rear fuselage mounted engines. The fuselage has 12 cabin windows on each side. The tail has the recognizable number two engine at its base, swept tailfin and mid-mounted swept tailplane. It holds a crew of two and up to 13 passengers. The Falcon 900 cruises at 540 mph and has a range of 4,000 nautical miles.
